Sarah B. Cooper, Lombard and Jones St. Cracks in stairwell.

Sherman, Union, near Gough St. Few plaster cracks.

Spring Valley, Jackson, near Hyde St. Cast stone fell from cornice. Plaster cracks.

Sunnyside, Foerster, near Hearst Ave. Few plaster cracks.

Sutro, Funston Ave., near California St. Few plaster cracks.

Twin Peaks, Corbett Ave. and Dixie St. Acoustical tile fell.

Visitation Valley, Visitation Ave. and Schwerin St. Few plaster cracks.

Washington Irving, Broadway, near Sansome St. Minor damage to wood.

Winfield Scott, Divisadero, near Beach St. Some roof tiles loosened.

San Francisco State College, 1600 Holloway Ave. No building sustained structural damage. Damage consisted mainly of plaster and window cracking. Approximately 70-80 windows in exterior sash required replacement. Continuous ground crack around the perimeter of one building. The crack was about 1/8 inch wide and about 6 feet away from the face of the building. Estimated cost of repairs to all buildings, \$26,530, with \$17,400 of the total cost required for the Library Building.

San Francisco (California Academy of Sciences, Golden Gate Park).
Motion rapid, lasted 1-1½ minutes. Direction NE and E-W. Felt by and frightened all. Loud earth noises heard. Shop machines rattled. Hanging objects swung. Books and electrical parts fell. Damage slight.

San Francisco (California Academy of Sciences, Golden Gate Park).
"Plaster damage in Dioramas in west wing (North American Wing). Plaster cracked at juncture of Diorama walls to roof beam. There was some debris on the skylights of the Dioramas which was thought to be paint flakes and plaster shaken loose by the shock. There was a very small crack, 3 inches long, in the bottom of the plate glass of the

second Diorama from the entry in the main lobby. There was a small spalled spot on the tail of the plaster model of the threshing machine in the display room at the northeast corner of the building. There is a statue outside the building near the northeast corner with a roof supported by four columns. One column cap was badly cracked and several columns were cracked."

San Francisco (Federal Office Building, Civic Center). Motion rocking, rolling, generally N-S. Felt by all. Creaking of building and rattling of loose objects heard by almost everyone. Disturbed objects observed by almost everyone. Visible swaying of buildings and trees. Some plaster cracks in south walls of building. One waste water main broke. Pictures swayed; file cabinets opened to 1 foot; mercury shaken out of cistern of recording barometer; instrument console shook, mechanically providing .01 inch precipitation. General alarm; few panic stricken. Ground: Sandy.

San Francisco (State Building, McAllister St., between Polk and Larkin Sts.). "First floor - East wall of hallway cracked at juncture of western two-story addition to the six-story central wing of original building. There were four vertical cracks in this wall with some cracks having plaster spalling from them. The west wall of the eastern two-story addition to six-story central wing of the original building was cracked. The cracks occurred where partitions abut this wall. Main stairs - east and west - Partition wall cracked at the landing between the third and fourth floors. The partition runs east-west. Horizontal cracks occurred about 6 inches above the landing. There were separation cracks between the plaster ceiling on the underside of the stairs and the metal stair stringers. These cracks were most noticeable between the third and fourth floors but occurred to some degree between the second and fifth floors."

San Francisco (Southern Pacific Building, 65 Market St., 10-story building, on 125-foot piling). Considerable plaster cracking and numerous windows cracked and broken throughout the building. Hollow tile walls throughout the ground floor offices cracked, some to the extent that surface plaster was removed. Some stall doors jammed in Women's Room on 6th floor.

San Francisco (Southern Pacific Building). Motion rapid, lasted 1 minute. Direction vertical, then E-W. Felt by and frightened many. Windows and doors rattled; walls creaked.

- Hanging objects swung. Electric clock stopped. Plaster and windows cracked. Damage slight. Ground: Filled in.
- San Francisco (Southern Pacific Building). Very strong. Direction seemed vertical, with W-E sway. Lasted about 2-3 minutes. Excited everyone. Building moved on piling very noticeably. Lights swung wildly. Drawers in desks and cabinets slid open.
- San Francisco (Ferry Building). Motion rapid, lasted about 10 seconds. Felt by all and frightened many on third floor (active; standing). Windows and doors rattled; building creaked. Ferry building clock stopped. Small objects and furnishings shifted. Plaster cracked. Few dishes broke. Damage slight. Ground: 120 feet bay mud.
- San Francisco (Ferry Building). Motion rapid, lasted about 8 seconds. Direction N. Felt by all in building. Windows and doors rattled severely; building creaked severely. Hanging objects swung N. Small objects overturned. Plaster cracked. Damage slight to plaster. Ground: Pier over fill.
- San Francisco (Berry St., between 3rd and 4th Sts.). Motion rapid, lasted 20 seconds. Direction E-W. Felt by and frightened all. "Just stopped my car, which rocked with a rolling motion. Freight cars on spur tracks moved. No visible damage at this site."
- San Francisco (675 Post St.). Large plate glass window broke.
- San Francisco (651 Brannan St.). Plate glass windows broke.
- San Francisco (Merchandise Mart, 1355 Market St.). Considerable minor pounding damage on every floor where original building joins annex.
- San Francisco (St. Francis Hospital, Hyde and Bush Sts.). Plaster cracked considerably. Small objects shifted. Ground: Soil, level.
- San Francisco (Mills Tower, Bush St., 6th floor). Motion slow, rolling, N-S, lasted 30 seconds. Loud noise like heavy thunder heard at beginning of shock. Felt by all in office building; frightened all in community. Windows, doors, and partitions rattled. Hanging objects swung N. Small objects shifted. Plaster, walls, and ceiling cracked; plaster fell. Damage slight to plaster. "Two girls hysterical; several persons nauseated." Ground: Compact, level.
- San Francisco (Sansome and Pine Sts.). Motion slow, N-S, lasted 30 seconds. Felt by all in office building; outdoors by others (active); frightened all in community. Windows and doors rattled. Hanging objects swung. Small objects shifted. Some persons became nauseated. Ground: Compact, level.

- San Francisco (Merchants Exchange Building, 465 California St.). Motion rapid, lasted 15 seconds. Felt by and frightened all. Windows and doors rattled; walls creaked. Plaster cracked. Damage slight. Ground: Rocky, filled in.
- San Francisco (465 California St.). Motion rapid, lasted about 35 seconds. Felt by all in reinforced-concrete building; frightened few. Prolonged rattling of windows and doors; prolonged creaking of building. Plaster cracked. Ground: Rocky.
- San Francisco (465 California St.). Commercial Club. Direction NE. Felt by and frightened all. Windows rattled. Small objects shifted. Ground: Level.
- San Francisco (465 California St., 10th floor). V. Direction E-W. Felt by all on 10th floor; by others outdoors (active); frightened many in community. Building rattled. Ground: Level, filled in.
- San Francisco (Post Street at Grant Avenue). Some debris from ledges, etc. Windows shook violently.
- San Francisco (Franklin Hospital, 14th and Noe Sts.). Motion sharp, lasted about 30 seconds. Earth noises heard by many. Felt by and frightened all. Windows, doors, and dishes rattled; building creaked. Small objects and furnishings shifted. Plaster cracked and fell. Damage slight.
- San Francisco (Stonestown, Emporium). Settlement of sidewalk. Plaster cracked.
- San Francisco (Stonestown, 360 Buckingham Way). Dishes and windows broke. Plaster cracked. Refrigerator and range twisted. Damage considerable to china, glassware, mirrors, etc. Ground: Sloping.
- San Francisco (Stonestown, 255 Buckingham Way, 9th floor). Dishes, windows, and furniture broke. Plaster cracked. Damage considerable to lamps, pictures, dishes, glass, and furniture. Ground: Level, filled in.
- San Francisco (Stonestown Market). Dishes and windows broke. Plaster, windows, and walls cracked. Deep crack in entire ceiling. Damage considerable to concrete. Ground: Sandy soil, level.
- San Francisco (Stonestown, 85 Buckingham Way). Small objects shifted. Dresser mirror broke. Plaster cracked. Damage slight. Ground: Filled in.
- San Francisco (Stonestown, Prudential Life). Safe and other large objects shifted. Plaster cracked. Damage slight to plaster. Ground: Soil, compact, level.
- San Francisco (Parkmerced, 100 Font Blvd., Apt. 11-L). Dressers shifted. Dishes broke. Walls cracked. Ground: Filled in, sloping.

- San Francisco (Parkmerced, 22 Fuente Ave.). Furnishings shifted. Dishes broke. Plaster and walls cracked. Damage slight to concrete. Ground: Sandy, level and sloping; filled in.
- San Francisco (Parkmerced Towers, 9th floor). Furnishings shifted. Plaster cracked. Damage slight. Ground: Soil, compact, sloping.
- San Francisco (Parkmerced Tower Apartments, 405 Serrano Dr.). Glassware, pictures, etc., shifted. Dishes broke. Plaster cracked. Damage slight. Ground: Probably soil, level.
- San Francisco (Parkmerced, 131 Bucareli Dr.). Small objects shifted. Plaster cracked. Damage slight. Ground: Soil, compact, level.
- San Francisco (Parkmerced, 3rd floor). Small objects and furnishings shifted. Plaster and walls cracked. Damage slight.
- San Francisco (Parkmerced, 120 Serrano Dr.). Small objects shifted. Plaster cracked. Damage very slight. Ground: Compact, level.
- San Francisco (634-45th Ave.). Motion rapid. Motion N-S and up and down. Felt by and awakened observer on first floor of weakly built wooden house. Windows, doors, and dishes rattled; house creaked. Hanging objects swung. Small objects shifted; vases overturned; knickknacks fell. Dishes and one vase broke. Damage slight. Dog terrified. Ground: Sandy, steep.
- San Francisco (87 Niagara Ave.). Two-story wooden back stairs collapsed.
- San Francisco (345 Randolph St.). Large amount of canned goods fell in store.
- San Francisco (1386-31st Ave.). Motion rapid. Felt by and frightened all. Windows, doors, and dishes rattled; house creaked. Small objects and furnishings shifted; vases and small objects overturned; knickknacks, books, and pictures fell. Ground: Compact.
- San Francisco (1910 Baker St.). Motion rapid, lasted about 30 seconds. Moderate earth noises heard. Small objects shifted. One dish broke. Small amount of plaster cracked. Ground: Sandy.
- San Francisco (1177 Valencia St.). Motion rapid, lasted 30 seconds. Loud earth noises heard at beginning of shock. Felt by and frightened all in home. Windows and doors rattled. Hanging objects swung. Small objects overturned. Plaster and walls cracked. Pictures fell. Damage slight. "Motion was like a spinning top, twisting and jarring, then aftershocks."
- San Francisco (NE corner of Broadway and Octavia). Motion rapid, lasted 1 minute. Felt by and frightened all in home. Windows,

doors, and dishes rattled; frame creaked. Doors swung. Small objects shifted and overturned. Pictures fell. Cracked plaster, and panel off of baseboards, which were distorted. Ground: Soil, sloping.

San Francisco (179-15th Ave.). "Front terrazzo stairs separated from stucco buttresses on side. Iron drainpipe on side of house bent and knocked loose from house." Ground: Soil, level.

San Francisco (678-11th Ave.). Windows, doors, and dishes rattled. Hanging objects swung E-W. Pendulum clock facing N stopped. Trees, bushes shaken strongly. Small objects and furnishings shifted; vases, etc., small objects overturned. Plaster cracked and fell. "Found minor damage at home. Floor lamps knocked over; cracks in plaster; small knickknacks broken; clock moved on mantel."

San Francisco (3233 Jackson St.). Motion rapid. Felt by all in home. Moderate earth noises heard. Windows rattled; walls creaked. Plaster cracked (most cracks old and widened a little). House (part rock and adobe) very well built. Ground: Rocky, soil.

San Francisco (470-19th Ave.). Motion slow after first jerk, lasted 15-20 seconds. Felt by all; frightened all in home. "House creaked so loudly could not have heard earth noises." Windows, doors, and dishes rattled. Hanging objects swung E-W. Small objects shifted; vases and small objects overturned; knickknacks and books fell from inside walls. Dishes broke. Damage slight.

San Francisco (265 Santa Clara). Motion slow, lasted 5 seconds. Direction S-N. Loud earth noises from S-N heard by many. Felt by many; frightened many in home. Windows, doors, and dishes rattled; house creaked. Hanging objects swung S-N. Trees, bushes shaken moderately. Small objects and furnishings shifted; small objects overturned. Plaster cracked. Knickknacks, books, pictures, and plaster fell. Slight amount of dish and window breakage. Damage slight. "Following shocks seemed to be jolts with no compass directions." Ground: Compact, sloping.

San Francisco (1870-9th Ave.). "Arrived home to find ornaments such as vases and knickknacks thrown across the room in a NE direction. Contents of bathroom cabinet fell out and door closed. Phonograph moved 8 inches from wall. Stairwell seemed to have sunk 1/4 inch. Second step down from front door chipped and cement at side of joint broken loose. Some loose plaster bits on stairs and in hall. Damage slight. Building wood-frame; two stories above garage."

San Francisco (2534-45th Ave.). Motion rapid, lasted 30 seconds. Loud earth noises heard by many 3 seconds before shock. Felt by and frightened all in home. Windows, doors, and dishes rattled; house creaked. Hanging objects swung. Furnishings shifted; vases and small objects overturned. Plaster and walls cracked. Knickknacks, books, pictures, and plaster fell. Dishes broke. Damage slight. Ground: Loose, sandy.

San Francisco (2218-31st Ave.). Motion jolting, then moderate shaking, lasted 1-2 minutes. Loud earth noises heard. Small objects fell from shelves. Bookcases and T.V. moved. Spring in 400-day clock broke; vases, bottle, and electric light on front porch broke. Ground: Sandy, sloping.

San Francisco (143 Brunswick St., Crocker-Amazon District). Motion rapid, eased off, then strong shaking. Moderate earth noises heard. Small objects shifted. Dishes broke. Plaster cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Compact, sloping.

San Francisco (1911 Hayes St.). Motion rapid, lasted 2 minutes. Direction W. Moderate earth noises from W heard by many. Felt by all; frightened few. Windows rattled; walls creaked. Hanging objects swung W. Small objects and furnishings shifted. Plaster, windows, walls cracked. Knickknacks, books, and plaster fell. Windows broke. Damage considerable. Ground: Rocky, compact, level.

San Francisco (1856-24th Ave.). Motion slow, lasted few seconds. Direction S-N. Loud earth noises from S-N heard by many. Felt by observer (active) on first floor of strongly built brick building (store); frightened many. Windows rattled. Pendulum clock stopped. All grocery merchandise fell off shelves. Store closed for five hours. Damage about \$1,500. Ground: Soil, level.

San Francisco (2858A-25th St.). Vases overturned; knickknacks fell. Plaster and walls cracked. Damage slight.

San Francisco (Sunset District). Observer living at 1310-29th Ave. "By comparison the homes on the west side of 29th Avenue all had cracked walls, fallen plaster, broken brick-a-brac, and opening of cabinet doors. Also, the stores on Irving Street, south side between 20th and 23rd Avenues, had broken windows, while those on the north escaped damage, although some have equally large windows."

San Francisco (252-3rd Ave.). Small objects and furnishings shifted; dishes broke. Damage considerable to concrete. Ground: Filled in.

- San Francisco (40 De Soto St.). Plaster, walls, chimneys cracked. Fireplace shifted 1/3 inch and facing loosened. Damage about \$200 to brick, masonry, and plaster. Ground: Soil, compact, sloping.
- San Francisco (2557 Alemany Blvd.). Grand piano shifted. Stair railings broke. Plaster, windows, walls, and chimneys cracked. Garage doors jammed. Damage considerable. Ground: Soil, compact, level.
- San Francisco (1367 Cayuga, near Geneva Ave.). Plaster, walls, and fireplace cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Filled in.
- San Francisco (1259 Cayuga Ave.). "Water draining from cracks in street." Few dishes and figurines broke. Damage slight. Ground: Soil and clay, compact, fairly level.
- San Francisco (103 Crescent Ave.). Walls and stucco cracked considerably. "I was working on a building under construction at the 200 block on Pine Street when the strongest shock occurred. It was a rolling N-S motion, lasting about 30 seconds. Whipping motion of flagpoles on the taller buildings nearer Market Street was the most notable effects in that area." Ground: Level, filled in.
- San Francisco (2419 Vallejo St.). Windows broke. Plaster and chimneys cracked; chimney fell.
- San Francisco (1515 Sloat Blvd., Lakeshore Plaza). Windows broke; plaster cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Loose, level.
- San Francisco (2247-34th Ave., Parkside District). Brick bulwark cracked; slight plaster cracks. Damage slight. Ground: Loose, level.
- San Francisco (11 Imperial Ave., Upper Marina). Plaster and walls cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Rocky.
- San Francisco (66 Santa Ana Ave., St. Francis Woods). Objects shifted, particularly heavy, loose objects. Stone fireplace cracked. Dishes broke. Damage considerable.
- San Francisco (255 Rolph St.). Dishes broke. Plaster and walls cracked. Damage considerable to concrete. Ground: Soil, level.
- San Francisco (3292-18th St.). Plaster, windows, and walls cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Filled in.
- San Francisco (426 Castenada Ave.). Dishes broke. Plaster, walls, and ground cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Rocky, loose, steep.
- San Francisco (1282-43rd Ave.). Dishes and windows broke. Plaster and walls cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Soil.
- San Francisco (61 Tinian Rd.). Incinerators cracked. Ground: Rocky soil, sloping.

- San Francisco (440 Ellington Ave.). Dishes and glassware broke. Plaster and walls cracked in every room of house. Damage considerable.
- San Francisco (151 Head St.). Dishes broke. Plaster and walls cracked. Damage considerable to brick, masonry, and concrete. Ground: Soil, loose, sloping.
- San Francisco (107 Eugenia St.). Dishes broke. Foundation had 3/8 inch crack; tongue and groove at intersection of floor in bathroom separated; pulled stair tread away from back of steps; moved fence. Damage slight to considerable. Ground: Rocky.
- San Francisco (Safeway Store, 4800 block on Mission St.). Dishes and windows broke. Plaster and windows cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Level.
- San Francisco (1251-18th Ave.). Dishes broke. Plaster and walls cracked. Damage considerable.
- San Francisco (2135-15th Ave.). Hot water heater, refrigerator, etc., shifted. Dishes and bric-a-brac broke. Plaster cracked; crack through basement floor and foundation. Water pipe leading into house broke. Damage considerable to concrete. "Several shocks felt." Ground: Sloping, steep; on hill.
- San Francisco (United Air Lines Building). Plaster cracked. Damage considerable to interior. Ground: Level, filled in.
- San Francisco (12 Mateo St.). Dishes broke. Ceiling and walls of entire house cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Soil, compact, steep.
- San Francisco (2527-23rd Ave.). Windows broke. Plaster and walls cracked. Damage considerable (about \$175). Ground: Soil, compact.
- San Francisco (385 Valdez Ave.). Dishes broke which were in a NE-SW line. Plaster and walls cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Sloping.
- San Francisco (Broad and Plymouth Sts.). Windows broke. Damage considerable. Ground: Level.
- San Francisco (2355-37th Ave.). Dishes and bric-a-brac broke. Plaster and walls cracked. Damage considerable to concrete terrazzo steps. Ground: Sand dunes; level.
- San Francisco (112 San Pablo Ave., St. Francis Woods). Furniture moved. Dishes broke. Many wall and ceiling cracks. Damage considerable. Ground: Soil, sloping.
- San Francisco (2643-38th Ave.). Dishes broke. Plaster and walls cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Level.
- San Francisco (95 Brookdale Ave., Sunnydale Housing Unit). "Could see whole structure in a cross-wise wrench and hear cracking sound of concrete giving way. So obvious was unsafeness

of concrete that I took child outdoors to clearing, away from any poles, lines, or buildings. Every door, window sill and jamb cracked. Concrete walls cracked. Have felt each aftershock, same line of direction to this room, where I sit and sew a good deal of the time." Damage considerable to concrete. Ground: Rocky, sloping; shelf cut in hill of rock; cement floor on rock bed.

San Francisco (243 Broad St.). Dishes and windows broke. Plaster, windows, and walls cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Sandy soil, level.

San Francisco (255 Ellington Ave.). Refrigerator moved 6 inches; stove moved 2 inches. Dishes broke. Plaster and walls cracked. Water pipe broke. Damage considerable. Ground: Soil, level.

San Francisco (516 Ellington Ave.). Dishes broke. Plaster and stucco cracked. Damage great to wood, brick, masonry, and concrete. Ground: Soil, level.

San Francisco (358 Randolph St.). Dishes, windows, and furniture broke. Plaster, windows, and walls cracked. Damage considerable to brick, masonry, and concrete. Ground: Sloping, compact.

San Francisco (739 Victoria St.). Plaster cracked in almost every room. Two chimney bricks fell. Damage considerable in living room: great number of cracks in plaster. Ground: Compact, sandy, level.

San Francisco (1489-18th Ave.). Plaster cracked in basement room from ceiling to floor, also smaller cracks in rooms on first floor. Damage slight.

San Francisco (792 Head St.). Plaster and walls cracked. Chimney fell. Damage considerable to wood and concrete. Ground: Loose, sloping.

San Francisco (435 Clipper St.). Plaster, walls, foundation, and ground cracked. Damage considerable to concrete. Ground: Soil, sloping.

San Francisco (61 Westwood Dr.). Dishes broke. Plaster cracked. Twisting and fall of chimney. Damage considerable to brick, masonry, and concrete (repairs about \$1,700).

San Francisco (210 San Benito Way). Refrigerator shifted. Dishes broke. Plaster and chimney cracked; chimney fell. Damage slight to brick, masonry, and concrete. Ground: Soil.

San Francisco (181 De Soto St.). Dishes broke. Plaster, walls, and chimney cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Soil, level.

San Francisco (446 Brunswick St.). Dishes broke. Damage considerable to concrete. Ground: Level.

- San Francisco (811 Head St., Ingleside Terrace). Dishes broke. Plaster cracked. Chimney twisted. Damage considerable. Ground: Level.
- San Francisco (380 Chester St.). "The earthquake was very intense, gathering great force with a giant jack hammer effect and with a slithering motion like a car with locked brakes going into a side slide. No warning rumble; rumble heard when shock reached peak shake. Lamps, knickknacks, china, and groceries all spewed out. My heavy oak china cabinet and massive table moved 2-3 inches away from original position; kitchen stove moved 2 inches; furnace in basement moved 2 inches off base and water heater tilted off base. Living room outer wall buckled. Plasterboard cracked throughout house, also outside plaster. Basement floor cracks look like a spider web. Electric wires outside snapped in two. Everything in our home was in a shambles. Constant tremors from 8:38 A.M. on Friday to 12:05 Sunday night, with one small tremor Monday morning. We are located at Junipero and Alemany Blvds." Ground: Soil, compact, slightly sloping.
- San Francisco (corner 6th Ave. and Balboa Sts.). Dishes, windows, and furniture broke. Plaster and walls cracked. Damage considerable. Ground: Compact, level.
- San Francisco (10 Homewood Court). Stove and refrigerator shifted. Dishes broke. Plaster cracked all over house outside; chimney cracked. Damage slight to considerable in bathroom between tile. Plaster cracks not wide. Ground: Sloping; filled in one year ago.

In house (upstairs) statues fell from shelves on east wall only. Chimney cracked above the roof, close to east wall of house. "No other house on our block had a broken window." Ground: Sand, slightly sloping.
- San Francisco (650 Stanyan St.).** Planter knocked off T.V. and two flower pots fell in dining room. All plants destroyed. Plaster cracks in living room and dining room; small bits of plaster on floor. Two small tables moved sideways from original position. Ground: Sandy soil, level.
- San Francisco (1440 Harrison St.).** Small objects shifted. Slab of marble broke on third floor. Damage slight. Ground: Level, filled in.
- San Francisco (1871 Page St.).** Light chest of drawers shifted 3-4 inches in southerly direction. Small top-heavy objects (perfume, lipsticks) knocked over on chest. Quite a bit of cracked plaster, enough for paint to chip and small pieces to fall. Worst cracks from top to bottom in corners of two rooms. "Some top-heavy objects (packages) stored on a narrow shelf were not knocked over. They were against a wall to the south, so it seems to me that the motion must have been from north to south." Damage slight.
- San Francisco (2126-35th Ave.).** Seven or eight potted plants fell from dining room table and broke; all fell to north side of table. Other small objects and figurines fell and broke. Kitchen stove shifted almost 1 inch to north.

INTENSITY VI - San Francisco

- San Francisco (241 Granada Ave.). Piano moved 3 inches from wall; desk and bookcase moved 6 inches. All lamps, books, bric-a-brac, and clocks thrown to floor; also, groceries, dishes, and plants. Three stucco cracks on south outer wall; two front stairs loosened and wall on either side cracked and broken for a height of 2 feet. Damage slight. Ground: Sandy soil, loose, level.
- San Francisco (Southern Pacific Yards, Visitacion Valley). Some material knocked off shelves in Stores Department on first floor. Plaster cracked. Damage slight. Ground: Level, filled in.
- San Francisco (286 Sagamore St.). Few plaster cracks; three window cracks. Picture fell and broke; several potted plants fell and broke; one glass broke; small bottles thrown from medicine chest and few broke. Worst damage was to intake pipe of hot water heater, where a crack opened up following aftershocks, making it necessary to shut off water. Damage slight.
- San Francisco (380 Pacheco, Forest Hills). Small objects and furnishings shifted. Dishes broke. Plaster, walls, and chimneys cracked. Damage slight. Ground: Soil, sloping.
- San Francisco (145 Carmel St., near Shrader). Two slight cracks in plaster walls on each side of stairs leading to basement. New terrazzo step cracked. Gas meter twisted forward, with slight leak at joint. Slight settlement of foundation. "I was thrown around and around in circles. Other shocks quite severe. Shocks have continued incessantly day and night." Damage slight. Ground: Sandy, rocky; house on steep incline.
- San Francisco (334 Orizaba Ave.). "House shook violently. Coffee spouted into the air from a cup that didn't turn over. Loud rumble virtually drowned out the sound of crashing dishes, breaking bottles, etc. Heavy refrigerator facing north moved 1½ feet away from south wall and swung west in more than a 30° angle. Stucco foundation chipped and cracked. Sounds from the aftershocks seem to come from west-east before the jerking and twisting motion. Aftershocks are still being felt (March 27)."
- San Francisco (3045 Jackson St., between Baker and Lyon Sts.). On 6th floor. Some large cracks with chipped paint and some hairline cracks. Shower of paint flakes in every room. Medicine cabinet cracked. Glassware moved; some broke. Pictures moved 5 inches. "Felt most aftershocks." Ground: Sloping; hill.
